Quality Long Term Care Gets More Complicated

It is always a challenge to find qualified, caring caregivers for an elder who is housebound. Quality care in skilled nursing facilities is always a moving target.

Things are getting worse.

The immigration crackdown is a visible cause of decreasing supply of caregivers. An Atlanta based facility, for example, reported that one third of its staff members were born in other countries. The Temporary Protected Status (TPS) allowed many individuals from countries beset by civil unrest or natural disasters to be and work in this country. The TPS status has been revoked for many, particularly from Venezuela and Haiti.

Nationally, over a million personal care aides and related workers in facilities are foreign born.

It is no secret that relatively few Americans accept this type of work because of the challnges and relatively low pay.

Inevitably, this means that the cost of care will go up as caregivers will expect and receive higher levels of pay in a competitive environment. This underscores the benefit of long-term care insurance. It underscores the benefit of retaining assets to pay for long term care if you are able.

Thinking logically, you must emphasize the involvement of the next two generations as you think about quality care. We focus on multi-generational planning, planning that benefits two or three generations, not just one.

What about Medi-Cal? Medi-Cal will still be available, we believe, for qualifying individuals in skilled nursing facilities that accept Medi-Cal. Over the next decade, we expect fewer facilities will accept Medi-Cal. This has significant quality and cost considerations.

The proverbial bottom line: talk with us in advance about planning for quality long term care. Seventy percent (70%) of us over the age of 65 will need some form of long-term care.

How POM Members Used their Hour

Mrs. L came to see us to address the role of Dynasty Trusts and the need for Special Needs Trusts for two family members. In addition to developing a plan to address these important goals, Mrs. L indicated that she wants to keep the house in the family as a "retreat."

This led to a discussion about Proposition 19 and the steps we can take to avoid the property tax increase. Notably, their property taxes are just over \$2,000 per year and they would increase to over \$35,000 per year unless protective planning steps are taken. We will no doubt be retained to capture and retain low property taxes so the house can be kept and enjoyed by future generations.

Ms. F called with regard to her mother's status. Her mother suffered a fall and is now receiving physical therapy in a facility with the costs covered by Medicare. Our client now understands that, if a skilled nursing facility becomes necessary, the state Medi-Cal available will be to her program notwithstanding assets that she has in the bank. Also discussed were strategies to achieve entry to the Medi-Cal certified skilled facility of choice. Caveat: The Medi-Cal rules change on January 1, 2026 and will be more restrictive.
